- iv) Nine students from third year BCOM got placed as Junior Executive at Flipkart.

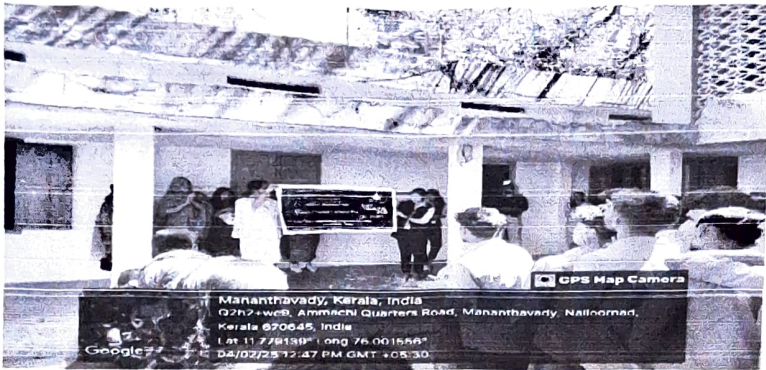
